Award-winning New Haven photographer Phyllis Crowley presents THINKING TWICE, an allnew addition to earlier work of meat and fish displays in foreign markets. This thoughtprovoking exhibit will be on view at City Gallery from Thursday, December 3 - Sunday, December 27. While there will be no opening reception, the artist will be at the gallery on December 6,13, and 20.

Crowley's series of photographs originated with trips to markets in Mexico, France and Spain, where she saw meat and fish displayed in ways she had never seen. "I was immediately captivated by the visual possibilities, combined with thoughts about the cultural differences and the treatment of living creatures."

In the 10 years since then, Crowley has visited many markets abroad, where she observed "sheets of backlit meat, fish or crabs wrapped around each other, making beautiful designs, often glistening in luscious colors under special lights."

"Many of the images look like paintings or landscapes," she explains. "But, at the same time that I saw the aesthetic possibilities in these subjects, I was also aware of

other things, like the cultural differences of these market displays and the suffering of even the simplest living creatures."

"As a human being as well as a photographer, I feel a responsibility to address these issues in my work."

A photographer from a very young age, Crowley is a well-known local artist with more than 40 years of professional and fine art experience. She taught photography at Norwalk Community College and the University of Bridgeport, and now teaches at Creative Arts Workshop in New Haven. She has exhibited across the country and has twice been awarded an Artist Fellowship from the Connecticut Commission on the Arts.
